Rev. Dr. Ruby Wilson, Senior Pastor, Safe Haven UCC and President,
Metropolitan Association, New York Conference, UCC, Preaching

Rev. Dr. Frederick W. Weidmann has accepted a call and has been serving *The Church-in-the-Gardens* as its pastor since February 2022. Prior to that he served as the Senior Minister of Hillcrest Congregational Church UCC, Pleasant Hill, CA. Previously, he has served on the faculty of both Union Theological Seminary and Auburn Seminary in New York, and on the clergy staff of The Riverside Church in New York.

Fred was ordained in the Metropolitan New York Synod (2002) and his primary call remains through the ELCA. He has held Dual Standing with UCC through both the Bay Association of the Northern California Nevada Conference and the Metropolitan Association of New York Conference.

Clergy are invited to robe and process. The liturgical color is **red**.
